DWM "Pre-regulatory"	The 15A NCAC 13B .1700 Rules came into effect on January 4, 1994 under the authority of NCGS 130A-294. Prior to this date, the requirements for notification of intent to construct a coal ash structural fill was not required. DWM may not have received complete information for these structural fills.
Recorded in Deed	Per 15A NCAC 13B .1707, a coal ash structural fill utilizing greater than 1,000 cubic yards of ash must be recorded on the property deed. Structural fills receiving written authorization from DWM prior to January 4, 1994 and those utilizing less than 1,000 cubic yards, do not have this requirement.
